We had not gone firm on a venue for Les' talk, but this will be resolved once we decide on a new date.

It is possible that the Committee will plan an outdoor event for either October or November, so please (as the saying goes) "watch this space."

(b) Branch Shields

Older members, (or should I rephrase that to read "longer serving members!"), may recall that a number of years ago the Branch purchased shields, or plaques, displaying the OMRS logo, for purchase by members and for presentation to guest speakers. Although we have not held any stock of these shields for many years, we have recently found an outlet in Hong Kong which manufactures them locally and we have placed an order. We expect this order to be delivered quite soon, and anyone who would like to purchase one (or more) is welcome to do so. These attractive shields are made of beechwood and can be either wall-mounted or free-standing on, for example, a sideboard. Cost will be \$340-HK each.
